The second General Body Meeting of Jammu University Teachers' Association was held on May 30, 2017 at 11:00 am in the main hall of Brig. Rajinder Singh Auditorium, University of Jammu. Hardly, the basic quorum was complete. The proceedings of the GBM started with a welcome address by Secretary JUTA, Dr. Yog Raj Sharma and then he invited president JUTA Dr. K. S. Charak to place the following agenda items before the worthy members of JUTA present at the GBM:

- 1. Presentation and discussion on the Constitution Review Committee Report
- 2. Progress Report of JUTA till date.

The President JUTA first presented a detailed report on the progress made by and then took up the Constitution Review Committee Report for presentation before the august house. After President's presentation, the report was thrown open for discussions and deliberations in the house. The members present in the house discussed the report in detail including the clause, 'JUTA office bearers term shall be two years instead of one year' was deliberated upon very seriously by all members. There were only 5% of the members present in the house who spoke against two years term for JUTA office bearers. Since two-third majority of the total membership (=170 members) is required to pass such amendments and there were only 107 members present in the GBM, the adoption of this amendment to the constitution could not happen. Majority of the members present at the GBM accepted that to satisfy the condition 'twothird majority of the total membership' is a kind of impossible situation (as evident from past meetings since JUTA came into existence) and they advised JUTA office bearers to go for adoption of the Amended Constitution by 'Circulation' among members of JUTA.

The GBM was concluded by a formal vote of thanks by the Vice-President of JUTA Prof. Lalitsen Sharma.
